









QUICK ID GUIDE - INVASIVES STRIKE FORCE - STANDARD SURVEY

TREES	<p>Norway maple (ACPL)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Tree</u>, opposite branching ○ Large leaves with pointed lobes, <u>milky sap</u> ○ Ridged bark ○ Seeds at <u>180° angle</u> 	
	<p>Tree-of-heaven (AIAL)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Tree</u>, alternate branching ○ Large compound leaves with many leaflets ○ Leaflets have <u>lobe at base</u> ○ <u>Smooth bark</u> with diamond pattern ○ Crushed leaf smells like rancid <u>peanut butter</u> 	
	<p>Autumn olive (ELUM13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Small tree or shrub</u>, alternate branching ○ Silvery leaves with <u>silver dots</u> on leaf & twig 	
	<p>Japanese angelica tree (AREL8)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Tree, large <u>doubly-compound</u> leaves with many leaflets ○ <u>Vertical thorn</u> at each leaflet node ○ Very <u>thorny stem</u> 	
SHRUBS	<p>Japanese barberry (BETH)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Shrub</u>, alternate branching ○ Small, straight <u>thorns</u> ○ Small, spoon-shaped leaves ○ Additional check: has yellow inner bark 	
	<p>Multi-flora rose (ROMU)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Shrub</u> with arching branches ○ Compound leaves with toothed edges ○ Green stems ○ Hooked <u>thorns</u> ○ <u>Fringed stipule</u> at base of leaves 	
	<p>Wineberry (RUPH)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shrub with arching branches ○ <u>Dense prickles</u> all along stem ○ Compound leaves with 3 leaflets, <u>fuzzy</u>, white underneath ○ Fruit is a raspberry, good to eat 	



QUICK ID GUIDE - INVASIVES STRIKE FORCE - STANDARD SURVEY

	<p>Burning bush (EUAL13)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Shrub, opposite branching ○ Sometimes looks like small tree ○ <u>Stems, green with brown ridges</u> aka “wings” ○ Leaves opposite 	
VINES	<p>Mile-a-minute vine (POPE3)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Triangular leaves</u> with petiole (stem) attached in middle below leaf ○ Curved <u>prickles</u> along the stem & leaf stalks ○ <u>Mint green</u> color ○ Fruit: blue berry ripening in July ○ Stems have joints with a round leaf-like stipule 	
	<p>Oriental bittersweet (CEOR7)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Vine</u>, twines around other plants ○ Leaves <u>alternate</u>, rounded and toothed ○ Leaves feel smooth, waxy ○ Fruit is hard berries – green now, will be orange when ripe <p>Additional check: has orange root</p>	
	<p>Japanese honeysuckle vine (LOJA)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ <u>Vine</u>, trails along ground or twines around other plants ○ Thin stems with pairs of <u>opposite</u> leaves (string with bow ties) ○ Leaves oval, rounded ○ Has fruit in pairs, juicy red berry (don't eat) 	
HERBACEOUS PLANTS	<p>Japanese knotweed (REJA2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Large plant with jointed <u>bamboo-like stems</u> ○ <u>Very large leaves</u> with somewhat <u>flat base</u> ○ Grows in thick colonies ○ Disturbed habitat 	
	<p>Garlic mustard (ALPE4)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Small, herbaceous plant ○ Dead skeletons ○ Clusters of basal leaves, <u>round or heart-shaped, toothed, wrinkled-looking</u> ○ White flowers, long narrow seed pods ○ Additional check: crushed leaf has <u>garlic smell</u> 	
	<p>Japanese stilt-grass (MIVII)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Soft grass-like plant, grows in patches ○ <u>Silvery stripe</u> down middle of blade ○ Easy to pull up – almost no roots ○ Thin weak stem
